All three artists are members of the Kaikai Kiki Corporation created by Takashi Murakami. These three young artists assert themselves as a new generation of Japanese artists.

Chiho Aoshima draws, on her computer, dreamlike images which seem to be her own nightmares. In this strange world, child-looking girls live, as well as mysterious creatures in a scenery of cemeteries, fun fairs and urban spaces. The characters evolve in a surreal, fascinating and amazingly violent universe. A "Bruegel" or a "Jerôme Bosch" of the numerical era? The work presented here is a monumental frescos, printed on paper, covering the all wall.

Aya Takano's drawings and paintings show young teenagers between dream and reality. These young girls are pictured with true sensuality. The paintings have a very soft texture.

Mr. has been noticed on the Japanese contemporary scene with a series of drawings and paintings representing lolitas and with performances evoking the universe of the Samurais. For this show, Mr. presents sculptures of Lolitas heads.
